Maria Giovanna DeLucia, known by everyone as “Jenny”, passed away peacefully at AtlantiCare Atlantic City on Wednesday at age 93. A beloved mother, sister, daughter, grandmother, great-grandmother, aunt, wife, and friend, she will be enormously missed by all.

Mrs. DeLucia grew up in Trenton, NJ, and was the daughter of Thomas and Theresa Andreaccio, both natives of Naples, Italy. In 1948, she married Frank DeLucia, also of Trenton, and they raised three daughters in the Chambersburg area, where she lived until 2015.

Jenny was a naturally skilled caretaker in every sense of the word. Family and friends often remarked on the incredibly delicious pasta dishes and holiday meals; her very devoted and selfless manner; and a beautiful smile and memorable laugh that made others feel at ease. Outside of her family, Jenny worked at the family’s dry cleaning business, Dress Rite Cleaners, which was a Burlington County staple for over 35 years.

Mrs. DeLucia is predeceased by her beloved husband Frank (d. 1992), brother Frank Andreaci (d. 2013), and sister Nancy Stephon (d. 2001). She leaves behind two surviving children, daughter Teresa Conklin and her husband Gary of Galloway, NJ; Patrice DeLucia of Trenton, NJ; a son-in-law Robert DiBianco (of eldest daughter Joan, d. 1999); grandson Lance DiBianco, his wife Alexa and their 10-month-old son Robert Charles of Fayetteville, NC; granddaughter Heather DiBianco of New York, NY; granddaughters Cortney and Cassidy Conklin of Galloway, NJ. Jenny also leaves a sister-in-law Arlene Andreaci, many nieces, nephews, cousins, and other relatives.


